MSCA HORIZON EUROPE: CALL MSCA PF 2021 – HOW TO WRITE A SUCCESSFUL PROPOSAL

Horizon Europe is the EU's key funding programme for research and innovation with a budget of €95.5 billion.

The Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions are the European Union's reference programme for doctoral education and postdoctoral training. They contribute to excellent research, boosting jobs, growth and investment by equipping researchers with new knowledge and skills, and foster research cooperation across borders, sectors and disciplines.

The objective of **Postdoctoral Fellowships** (PFs) is to support researchers' careers and foster excellence in research. The Postdoctoral Fellowships action targets researchers holding a PhD who wish to carry out their research activities abroad, acquire new skills and develop their careers. PFs help researchers gain experience in other countries, disciplines and non-academic sectors
